Crop cultivation

Course content

The course will focus on preparing cultivation plans for the most common crops. The following areas are worked on, among other things, on a theoretical basis:

- Crop rotation plans
- Environmental impact
- Fertilization plans
- Cultivation with or without chemicals
- Coverage contribution calculations

The teaching will primarily be classroom teaching, where the students work on preparing cultivation plans. As a supplement to classroom teaching, the students must visit the field. The course is a continuing course at an advanced level.

Competence targets

The aims of the course:

- The student can explain environmental impacts that occur as a result of plant production
- The student can explain the establishment of sales and fodder crops, including requirements for seeds, seed beds, soil treatment methods and sowing techniques.
- 3. The student has knowledge of conservation and storage of forage crops
- The student can participate in the planning of a production of general sales and forage crops.
- 5. The student can participate in the preparation of cultivation and crop rotation plans for a farm.
- 6. The student can use spraying plans and prepare spraying journals
- 7. The student has knowledge of the economic conditions of plant production and can explain the calculation of contribution margin in plant production

Trelleborg Viking Fortress

One of the places where the Viking Age can be experienced close at hand is the Viking fortress of Trelleborg, near Slagelse in West Zealand. The impressive remains of one of the Vikings' great ring fortresses were originally constructed around AD 980 by King Harald Bluetooth and are located in the beautiful area of Tude ådal. The museum at Trelleborg includes models, archaeological finds and reconstructions that give a vivid impression of Trelleborg's history, its inhabitants and the function of the fortress.
