You'll be introduced to the essentials of floral arranging, with a strong focus on elegant Nordic-style bouquets and decorations, color theory, and flower care.

Throughout the course, you'll work hands-on with fresh flowers in a practical and visually engaging environment. While creativity is at the heart of our teaching, you'll also gain a solid foundation in the theory behind floral design.

As part of the program, you'll be introduced to the Danish flower industry and take part in our school's commitment to promoting sustainability in floristry.

You'll go on inspiring field trips to central Copenhagen to explore leading flower shops, and visit Danish wholesalers and local flower producers to see the industry in action.

Along the way, you'll also have the chance to connect with Danish floristry students—building international friendships and exchanging creative ideas across cultures.
