Roskilde Technical VET College

At Roskilde Technical VET College we aim to inspire students to become responsible global citizens by raising awareness of environmental challenges and encouraging action for a more sustainable future.



Roskilde Technical VET College is a Member of the Associated Schools Network.

In Denmark, 80 educational institutions are part of the network, including primary schools, continuation schools, high schools, vocational schools, university colleges and others. All schools in the network are committed to working on global citizenship and sustainable development. At Roskilde Technical VET College we work with the SDGs wherever we meet them.



Roskilde Technical VET College offers several vocational education and training programs, HTX (Higher Technical Examination, an upper secondary education) and more advanced technical education. We also offer further education for skilled workers, company-related courses and introductory courses for primary school pupils.

The college participates in several international activities, pilot projects and teacher/student exchanges.

The Danish VET System

The Danish vocational education and training system (VET system) offers more than 100 different types of vocational educations and even more vocational specializations. The duration of the vocational educations varies from 1½ to 4½ years.

VET consists of a basic programme divided into two basic courses and the main programme. The basic programme is school-based and in the second part of this the students choose their field of education within the VET programmes.

The main programme is built upon the dual principle, where the students alternate between school and apprenticeship. The student must have a training agreement with an approved company which offers training. The school supports the students in achieving this.

Cultural Experiences

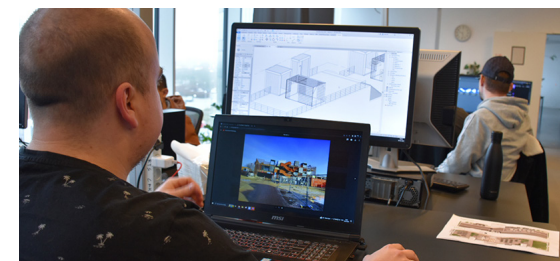
Denmark has a long tradition of architecture and culture reflected in many historical buildings, churches and monuments.

The train ride from Copenhagen Central Station to Roskilde Station takes 25 minutes – and 30-45 minutes from the CPH Airport in Copenhagen.

A World Heritage Site, Vikings and rock-n-roll await you in the cathedral city of Roskilde. History, culture and beautiful nature are in generous supply, not to mention inviting restaurants where you can relax and soak up your experiences.

The history of Roskilde and the surrounding areas dates back to the Viking and Middle Ages. Visit the royal tombs in Roskilde Cathedral, an impressive architectural gem that has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

RAGNAROCK museum in the exiting Musicon district offers interactive exhibitions on rock and pop music and youth culture. And the Viking Ship Museum showcases Denmark's seafaring history with well-reserved Viking ships and living historical workshops.
